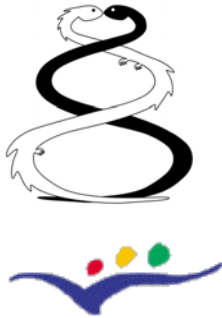

### A. Project Profile

- Scientific and psychosocial continuing education
- For members of helping professions
- With a complementary medicine or psycho-social background
  
- Taking into account already acquired practical (therapeutic) knowledge
- Furthering education toward a dual profile including therapeutic knowledge and theory
- Master of Health and Resources Promotion (MSc)
- With deepened psycho-social competency and
- Qualification for research, teaching and public service through
  
- *Health-related knowledge, general health promotion*
- *Communication skills in helping relationships*
- *Research knowledge and inter-disciplinary dialog skills*
- *Understanding of paradigms and methods of complementary, particularly regulative, approaches as a possibility for resources promotion*

## **B. Target Group**

Persons from healthcare related / helping professions with competency in complementary medicine / psycho-social, therapeutic, counselling, pedagogic or scientific areas, who have a deepened psycho-social proficiency as well as aspire qualification for research, teaching and public service.

## **C. Qualification of Graduates**

The curriculum will always take into account your already acquired knowledge. Be it a healthcare related college degree or, upon consultation, several years of practical experience and continuing education in a healthcare related occupation. The main focus of the continuing education should be in a complementary medicine or psychosocial field.

Adding to this foundation, psychosocial skills will be honed, and the previously acquired knowledge will be reflected upon in a scientific manner. It may be that, upon graduation with a Master degree, you will be doing what you did before, but you will be doing it better and with a greater sense of satisfaction and efficiency.

Further teaching goals or qualifications, especially for a Master degree, include competency in research, teaching and public service, ideally, in your original field.

The courses focus on the health resources inherent in the therapist and the client, the innate psychological and physical powers and possibilities. Autonomy and self-actualisation (client-centred therapy) are proposed versus provider dependence (provider-centred therapy); lasting and fundamental healing seem to be impossible to differentiate from self-healing. In addition to this perspective concerning the individual, we emphasize the influence of social conditions on the possibility of people to live health.

In this manner the curriculum promotes a social sense of responsibility as well as the realization that healing and health are not be treated as consumer products, but must be actively co-created."

## **D. Project Goals**

- Developing a Europe-wide clear standard of scientific and psychosocial further education in the "complementary" field with certification in an EU-wide network of collaboration through university-level degrees (certificate resp. Master, or local university degree). Explicit participation of universities and other partners from EU countries in product development, audit and/or project evaluation.
- Creating a matching correspondence course system (Internet materials in collaboration with the University of Neubrandenburg, CD-ROM and book manuscripts) and the logistics of a combined trans-national local and correspondence course with trans-national accreditation.
- Establishing a Europe-wide harmonized continuing education system for members of helping professions with a focus in complementary medicine to become experts in health and resources promotion in accordance with national laws governing education and labour and in cooperation with the established complementary medicine and psycho-social education and training facilities.
- Clear coverage of the education and quality levels of cooperating professional associations.
- Recognition by institutions like the ministries of health and science, physicians, and other professional representations.

## **E. Products**

- Establishing the project in civil law with the petitioning institution being the responsible party, in cooperation with the partners
- Homepage with clear depiction of the pursued goals (in German and English, with a summary in other EU languages), also on CD-ROM
- Layout of the entire curriculum on the homepage, as printed material as well as CD-ROM (in German and English)
- Elaboration of the essence of the courses in form of multi-media lectures, as CD-ROM and as printed version in a series of text books (both in English and German)
- Access to an electronic communication platform
- Issuance and/or award of the relevant trans-national Master degree by the Validation Board of the University of Wales, for example, the Austrian Ministry of Education, Science and Culture, or if necessary founding of a private university.
- Establishment of a EU-wide network of cooperation, audit and evaluation partners for the curriculum
- Informing diverse occupational representations, for example, associations of health-related, social and care-giving professions on a national and trans-national basis.
- Information platform for the public
- Logistics of the subsequent implementation of the courses, partner and seminar structure, business administration
- Parallel anchoring of the curriculum in several locations
- Trans-national continuing education for faculty
- Public announcement of the curriculum, applications via Internet, printed material and media, preparation of initial seminars
