As to our knowledge non-communicable diseases (NCDs) are the leading cause of disease and disability in our whole world. From the medical point of view the four major NCDs (cardiovascular disease, cancer, chronic obstructive pulmonary diseases and diabetes) together count globally for the vast majority of the disease burden and of premature mortality. At the same time, NCDs are responsible for many of the growing health inequalities that have been observed in many countries, showing a strong socioeconomic gradient and important gender differences. We are researching over a system of transformation of facts and data, leading to special medical establishment, nursing and care against NCDs. Plan and concept summarize digitalization and e-learning for qualification and education against risks of NCDs. This preliminary report invites to take part on simultaneous surveys.
